

Program Workflow



1

HCV SCREENING ELIGIBILITY

Screen all adults 18 and older once. Uninsured patient's screening labs will be covered by the program. Insured patients will have their screening lab billed through their insurance.

2

PROVIDE EDUCATION & COMPLETE FOLLOW UP STAGING LABS

- If HCV positive, bring pt in for education using our mobile app
- Uninsured, chronically infected patients will be enrolled in the STOP HCC-HCV program
- Insured patients need to be referred out to specialty care
- Program enrolled pts should complete follow-up labs during the same visit

3

SCHEDULE HCV TELECONSULTATION CALL

- Pt review form will be put together by the program, and a call will be set up between the provider and hepatologist to recommend treatment
- Program will send clinic provider a signed treatment recommendation letter by the hepatologist for their records

4

PAP APPLICATION

- Once a treatment recommendation is made, program will send over a PAP application for pt and provider signatures
- PAP application will be faxed to the program with needed supplemental documents
- Application will be processed within 2 weeks

5

START OF HCV TREATMENT

- Pt will receive meds in mail (via FedEx), and an appointment with patient will be made to discuss instructions and record start date
- The start date will determine when the pt will return for follow-up labs

6

END OF TREATMENT LABS

Pt will need an HCV RNA Quant at the end of treatment to determine if treatment was effective

7

12-WEEK POST TREATMENT LABS

Pt will need an HCV RNA Quant and CMP lab 3 months after they finish treatment

8

CURED!

If 12-week post treatment lab is "Not Detected" pt is now considered cured of HCV!
